2013 Trujillo Cabernet Sauvignon Healy Vineyard Reserve

Healy Vineyard consists of four and a half acres on the northwestern edge of St. Helena, a renowned area for growing fine Cabernet Sauvignon grapes. Alluvial clay loam from Sulphur Creek fan provides superb drainage while cooling winds passing between Spring Mountain and the Mayacmas range allow clusters to ripen slowly. Over many years of working with this distinctive property, I've found that wines crafted from its fruit are of balanced richness, exhibiting plushness and complexity over bold power. I'm pleased to showcase Healy Vineyard in my Trujillo Reserve series of single vineyard wines. Well rounded and beautiful complex, this wine is approachable now and will age gracefully with time.

The aromatics are silky and rich with amazing depth. Coco and plum rush forth with hints of licorice and sweet cedar. Smooth and velvety with an abundance flavors of dark cherry and dark plum. A dark chocolate note is unmistakable and lingers throughout. A signature of this vineyard site. Satisfying with finesse and grace rather than boldness and tannin.
