2013 Trujillo Cabernet Sauvignon Gary Morisoli Vineyard Reserve

Gary Morisoli Vineyard is located near the western foothills in what I truly believe is the sweet spot of the Rutherford Appellation, where the dusty, gravelly, loam soil produces rich dark fruit with complex structure. Owned and farmed for decades by Gary Morisoli, this renowned Rutherford Bench site delivers exceptional Cabernet grapes year after year.

This vintage definitely merited a vineyard designated bottling. I only release the rare, small production Trujillo Reserve when conditions in the vineyard and the resulting fruit are absolutely impeccable! It's a Cabernet Sauvignon that will age as gorgeously as Gary's vines have over the years. Please enjoy this unique marker of time and place.

Deep, rich and bold is defiantly this wine's character. Dark fruits of black currant, black cherry with spicy, dusty notes that are signature for this great Rutherford Cabernet. As the wine swirls in the glass the wonderful aromas continuously come forth adding to its depth and complexity. In the initial tastes, the wine is a bit cocooned showing that is boldly structured as an exceptional Cabernet but given time, generously unfolds. Rich confident flavors of bold black cherry and black currant are well laced with perfect acidity to carry this wine into time gracefully.
