Vintage Notes

The Henry Brothers Howell Mountain vineyard is proving to be an exceptional producer of great Cabernet Sauvignon along with the other Bordeaux varietals of Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot and Malbec. Being that all five Bordeaux varieties are grown on this single vineyard sight gives opportunity in creating an exceptional cabernet blend. This very select blend of 2015 Henry Brothers Reserve is an expression of not only the Howell Mountain AVA, but the artful and unique blending of five Bordeaux varietals from a single site. This wine is fun making!

This wine jumps forth with generous, plush aromas of black cherry and red cherry. Showing some violet notes along with a spice, cedar and hints of nutty vanilla from the French oak aging. The wine opens up rapidly and generously *with-it* aromatics bringing forth depth, richness and complexity in the nose. Each swirl of the glass has this wine awaking - giving forth more and more to be enjoyed.

Flavors are full, rich and generous of black cherry, blackberry and plum. The multi-dimensional and forward fruit expressions all lace together perfectly to carry this wine firmly from start to finish. Perfectly balanced with its structure, tannin and texture lend way for a rich smooth lengthy finish for this stunning mountain cabernet.

Rich and Elegant with finesse and complexity. A great expression of this unique Howell Mountain vineyard. This wine can be enjoyed now with proper decanting and/or over the next several years.
