2016 Madelyn Rosé

In life, as in winemaking, a blend of great things often results in something fun and unique. Daily experiences, great and small, become even more remarkable when shared with those we love. I personally feel blessed to share each day with my darling daughter, Sophia. In her honor, I am proud to make Madelyn Rosé, a wine that express the joy I have found in her company. The wine's name comes from her middle name: Sophia Madelyn.

The grapes that go into the making of this delicious rosé wine come from the cooler wine regions of Sonoma. Crafted mainly from Syrah grape varietals, there are hints of a Muscat varietal and Sauvignon Blanc blended into the Syrah base. These added varietals elevate the aromas and complement the flavor. A generous nose of red raspberry, strawberry and hints of pomegranate elevate into a delicate, almost creamy aroma that offers a wonderful depth and broadness. This luscious mix of red fruit in the aromas captivates your senses and taste buds to enjoy those same red fruit flavors. Crisp and bright with delicate raspberry and strawberry flavors carry the wine through seamlessly. The result is a beautifully colored and refreshing rosé with a lingering silky finish.

Rosé wine is meant to be enjoyed in casual settings. Hands down, the 2016 Madelyn Rosé is a great summer wine for picnics, BBQs, or simply entertaining and relaxing by your pool in the company of friends and family. Our suggestion is to pair this wine with mildly spicy foods. If you like rosé, you'll love our Madelyn Rosé.
