2019 TRUJILLO RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON HEALY VINEYARD

Vintage Notes



Healy Vineyard is one of the three key vineyards for Trujillo Cabernet. It consists of four and a half acres on the northwestern edge of St. Helena. The alluvial clay loam soils from the Sulphur Creek fan provide superb drainage while cool winds between Spring Mountain and the Mayacamas range allow clusters to ripen slowly. Its densely planted, meter by meter, vine-spacing contributes to a consistent uniformity each and every vintage. Wines made from this site are elegance, over power.

This wine showcases the amazing vineyard site. It exhibits great depth and a velvety texture, with a plush and silky finish. This wine is always a crowd pleaser for its approachability, yet still bold with silky fitness. Up front with lush black fruits woven with a dusty cocoa element and a hint of sweet pepper. The aromas are overgenerous with blackberry, dark currant, sweet dark plum, and spice. On the palate sits black cherry and cassis, rich and uplifting. Fine tannin carries the wine to a long flavorful, silky finish. Its signature notes of mocha aromas are delightfully laced throughout.

I'm pleased to showcase this amazing Healy Vineyard once again with the 2019 vintage. It is a notable Cab offered in the Trujillo Reserve single vineyard series. This vintage carries a bit more power and density, but is still the velvet glove style Cabernet we have all enjoyed in the past. To summarize, rich, velvety, plush, & lush. It is approachable now with gentle decanting and will only improve with time! Drink 2022 - 2035.
