



2022 Trujillo Chardonnay - RP 93 points

Trujillo sources his Chardonnay from Oak Knoll but eschews malolactic fermentation, choosing to enrich the wine with stirring and lees contact. Scents of grilled bread, struck match, white peach and melon appear on the nose of the 2022 Chardonnay, while the medium-to full-bodied palate is expansive and generous, then comes to a bright, focused finish.





2021 Trujillo Cabernet Sauvignon - RP 92 points

Trujillo's 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley includes components from several Napa AVAs, including Rutherford, St. Helena, Oak Knoll and Howell Mountain. It's not a bombastic wine but rather restrained, with cedary accents and hints of dried spices to the black cherry fruit. It's medium- to full-bodied and silky-velvety in texture, not overly concentrated but nicely balanced and textured, with ample length on the finish.





2021 Trujillo Gary Morisoli Reserve - RP 97 points

Always some of the best grapes Trujillo has had to work with, the 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon Gary Morisoli Vineyard marries black cherries and dusty earth with hints of cedar and vanilla. It's full-bodied, silky yet rich and complete—it's hard to find anything to critique on the palate, while the long finish adds beguiling hints of licorice and dark chocolate.





2021 Trujillo Madelyn Red Wine Cuvée - RP 90 points

A selection of less-concentrated lots, blended for approachability, Trujillo's 2021 Madelyn Red Wine Cuvée is a blend of 35% Cabernet Sauvignon, 28% Syrah, 18% Merlot, 11% Cabernet Franc and 8% Malbec. Cherries, dusty earth and a bit of dried sage appear on the nose, while the medium- to full-bodied palate is lighter, less extracted and less tannic than Trujillo's varietal Cabernets, but it's still silky, pretty stuff.
