2022 TRUJILLO RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON LAMOREAUX VINEYARD

Vintage Notes



The Lamoreaux Vineyard is located toward the southern end of Napa Valley on the western foothills of the Oak Knoll District AVA. The vineyard's proximity to the San Pablo Bay imparts more of a marine influence. The cooler and more moderate climate along with longer fruit hang time on the vines allows for a slow and subtle ripening, giving this wine an uplifting brightness in its fruit expression and overall structure. Wines from this area will express finesse, great texture, and elegant complexity.

The personal connection I have with this site, as well as the wisdom shared by my mentor Andre Tchelistcheff, adds layers of significance to this wine's story and quality. This 2022 vintage will also mark the fourth notch symbolizing my 4th decade of winemaking in the Napa Valley!

This Lamoreaux Reserve Cabernet showcases its big, rich, and plush characteristics alongside bright and focused expression of a great old-world style Cabernet Sauvignon. The lavish aromas of red currant, spice, black cherry, cocoa powder, sage, black licorice, and sweet tobacco leaf promise a sensory journey. The firm yet layered palate, supported by bright acidity from the cooler growing region, laces this wine seamlessly together to carry it forward for many years come.

My pride and excitement for this Reserve Cabernet release shine through in the description, highlighting not only the quality of the wine but also the deep connections and history embedded in each bottle. Drinking great now with decanting yet easily ageable in your wine cellar through 2040
