2023 TRUJILLO RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON GARY MORISOLI VINEYARD

Vintage Notes

The Gary Morisoli Vineyard sits in the heart of the Rutherford Bench, tucked against the western foothills of the Rutherford AVA. It is, without question, one of my favorite vineyards in the appellation. This exceptional site is known for producing Cabernet Sauvignon with the unmistakable character of Rutherford, and its well-drained gravelly loam soils give the wines incredible depth, rich dark fruit, and beautiful structure. To me, the Morisoli Vineyard represents the sweet spot of the Rutherford Appellation. Year after year, its consistency and ability to produce Cabernet Sauvignon of Reserve caliber make this vineyard truly special.



The 2023 vintage showcases everything I love about this vineyard. The wine opens with generous, inviting aromas of unrestrained dark fruits like black cherry, dark currant with a hint of sweet tobacco, all accompanied with the infamous and unmistakable signature of "Rutherford dust." On the palate, rich layers of dark fruits of black cherry, lush currants and bitter-sweet chocolate fill the glass, creating a wine that is both powerful and beautifully polished. Refined tannins and vibrant acidity provide balance, length, and structure, while allowing the layers of fruit and complexity to unfold with every swirl and every sip.

The Gary Morisoli Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon will continue to develop beautifully with time in the bottle. The 2023 vintage is balanced and approachable now, especially with a little time in the decanter, but its depth, structure, and refined tannins make it a wine that will reward patience. While drinking beautifully today, this Cabernet has the concentration and balance to evolve gracefully for many years, with a drinking window that should extend through 2040 and beyond.
